


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## WHY IS PLANNING IMPORTANT?

These universities often have high entry requirements, prestigious reputations, and offer top-tier programs in various fields. Admissions chances are low as these are highly competitive

#### **Target:**

universities Target are institutions where a student's academic qualifications, test scores, and extracurricular activities align well with the school's admission criteria. These universities considered realistic options for admission based on the student's current profile. Essentially, students are likely to have a good chance of being accepted, but acceptance is not quaranteed.

#### Match:

Match universities are institutions where a student's academic qualifications, test and overall profile scores, closely align with university's admission criteria. These schools are considered realistic and achievable options for the student, offering a good chance of admission based on student's qualifications and application.

#### MISTAKES TO AVOID FOR ADMISSIONS

- Procrastination and delaying preparation: Many students wait until the last minute to start their application. This can lead to rushed, incomplete, or lower-quality applications. Start early to give yourself ample time to gather documents, write essays, and meet deadlines.
